What is consent?

Consent means you say yes or no.

You choose what happens with your information.

You choose who we can talk to about you.



Your choices

You can say yes to sharing.

You can say no to sharing.

You can change your mind at any time.

You can take your time to decide.

You can ask questions first.



Who might we share with?

Only if you say it is okay, we might share with your family or carer, your doctor, your school, or other people who help you.

You can choose to share with some people and not others.



When must we share without asking?

Sometimes we must share to keep you or someone else safe.

Sometimes the law says we must.

If this happens, we will tell you where we can.



We check with you as we go

We do not only ask once.

We keep checking that you are happy.

We ask again when something new happens.
